Aust. Soil Class.: Bleached, ?, Brown CHROMOSOL (confidence level 4).

General Land Unit Description:

This land unit comprises imperfectly drained basalt soils on gently undulating to level plains. The soils are indicative of imperfectly drained soils, exhibiting a bleached A2 horizon and mottled subsoil.

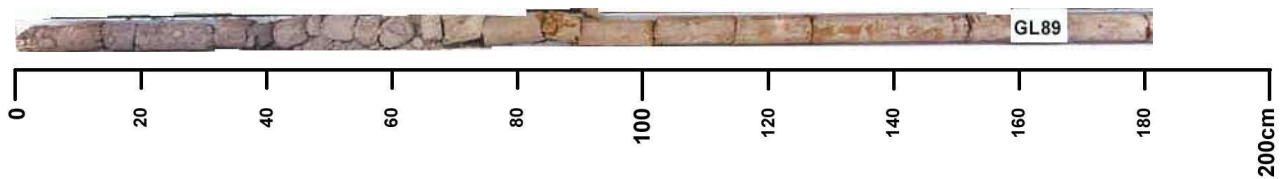
Site Description:
